H O L B R O O K

Holbrook is 262 m above sea level and is located 494 km south-west of **Sydney** and 384 km north-east of **Melbourne** on the Hume Highway between Gundagai and Albury.

Until 2013, Holbrook was one of the last towns not bypassed by the Hume Highway. Now, Holbrook is an ideal stopover and rest destination.

Submarines, Antiques, and Pottery

Located in Submarine Park is the HMAS Otway, a 90-metre submarine, dominating the townscape. Next door is the Submarine Museum. Holbrook is also home to the National Museum of Australian Pottery and Woolpack Inn Museum.

Bushwalks and National Parks

The Ian Geddes Bushwalk follows Ten Mile Creek away from Albury Street into a tranquil bushland domain. It is accessible from the main street and can be comfortably completed in 30 minutes. For longer walks and spectacular views, the Woomargama National Park is only a short drive away.
